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## StashBuster Club Supply List “Over and Above”

### Pattern Handout

If using your stash with a 6”, 8”, 9”, follow yardage below for a 16 block quilt.

If you have a 12” Qube, use same yardage, but you’ll make a 9 block quilt.

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut 1—5½" x 11" rectangle. Fanfold into a 5½" width. Sub cut into 8—2" squares. You will use 5 squares for each block.	16—5½" x 11" pieces
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut 1—5½" x 5½" square. Lay on die and cut 4—2" squares.	16—5½" squares
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut a 5" x 20" width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 4—signature blocks.	16—5" x 20" pieces

Fabric Color	Shapes to Cut	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Beige		Cut 5—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 128—2" finished half square triangles (HST).	1½ yards
Beige		Cut 10—2½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55017 or 55014). Sub cut into 40—2½" x 10½" rectangles for sashing.	Yardage included above
Blue Gray		Cut 1—5½" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Sub cut into 25—2" squares.	½ yard

If you are purchasing fabric yardage, get 4 yards total for the scrappy blocks. Still follow yardage for the beige, and blue gray fabric.

If you’d like to add borders:

1/2 yard for inner border ( cut 6 strips 2-1/2” x WOF)

1-3/4 yard for outer border (cut 8 strips 6-1/2” x WOF)

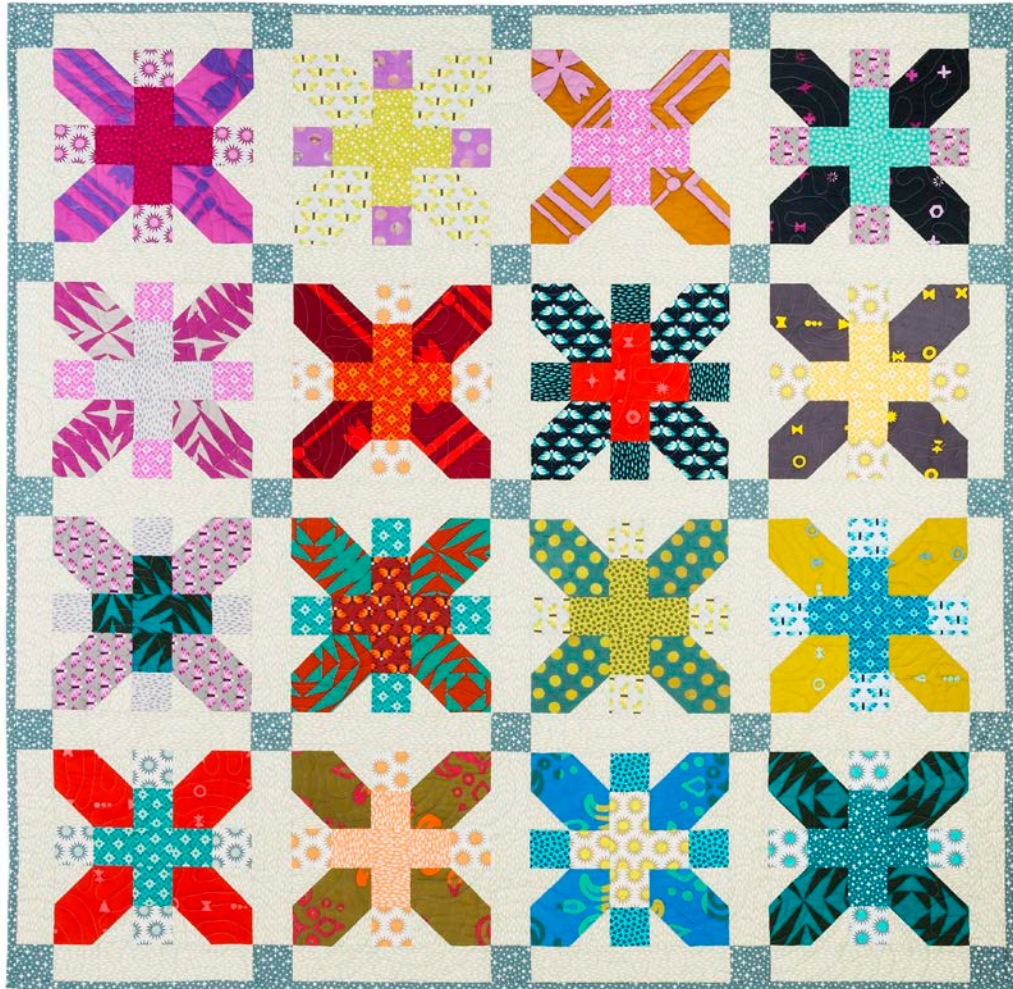
Do NOT bring your sewing machine.

## GO! Qube 8" Over and Above Quilt

Finished Size: 50" x 50"

For use with GO! Qube™ Mix & Match 8" Block (55776) and  
GO! Qube™ 8" Companion Set-Classics (55780)



### Dies Needed:

#### GO! Qube Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)

- GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (Shape 5)

#### GO! Qube 8" Companion Set-Classics (55780)




- GO! Signature Block-4" Finished (Shape 10)





### Additional Dies Needed:

GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

**Cutting Directions:**

The cutting instructions for the assorted scraps are the colored pieces for ONE block. These cutting instructions will have to be repeated 16 times each to achieve the scrappy look.

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut 1—5½" x 11" rectangle. Fanfold into a 5½" width. Sub cut into 8—2" squares. You will use 5 squares for each block.	16—5½" x 11" pieces
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut 1—5½" x 5½" square. Lay on die and cut 4—2" squares.	16—5½" squares
Assorted Scraps for 16 Blocks		Cut a 5" x 20" width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 4—signature blocks.	16—5" x 20" pieces

Fabric Color	Shapes to Cut	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Beige		Cut 5—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 128—2" finished half square triangles (HST).	1½ yards
Beige		Cut 10—2½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55017 or 55014). Sub cut into 40—2½" x 10½" rectangles for sashing.	Yardage included above
Blue Gray		Cut 1—5½" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Sub cut into 25—2" squares.	½ yard
Blue Gray		Cut 6—2½" x WOF strips for binding using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014).	Yardage included above

**Additional Fabrics Needed:**

- Batting: 60" x 60"
- Backing: 3 yards

## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

**NOTE:** The following sewing directions are for ONE block. Repeat the directions 16 times to achieve the desired scrappy look.

1. Pin and sew one beige 2" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to bias edge of one signature block (Shape 10) as shown. Press seams toward HST. Repeat on opposite side of signature block as shown. Make 4 signature block units.
2. Pin and sew one scrappy 2" finished square (Shape 2) to a different scrappy 2" finished square (Shape 2). Press towards the darker square. Make 4— $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle units as shown.
3. Lay out four signature block units, four rectangle units and one 2" finished square (Shape 2) as shown. Pin and sew into three horizontal rows. Press signature block units toward rectangle units. Press center square toward rectangle units. Pin and sew the three horizontal rows together. Press toward center rectangle/square row. Block will measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
4. Repeat Steps 1 through 3 to make a total of 16 scrappy blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in four rows of four adding sashing and cornerstones as shown. Pin and sew the horizontal rows first. Pressing toward the sashing. Pin and sew rows together. Pressing toward sashing.



## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
