


Pattern Fabric Qube Die # Loretta’s Sample (8” Qube)

Dark Purple (A)		1/3 yd	Blue Grunge
Medium Purple (B)		1/3 yard	Blue Swirls
Almond (C)		3/4 yard	White
Almond (D)			White
Dark Green (E)		3/8 yard	Navy
Light Green (F)		3/8 yard	Blue/Green Batik

Border 1—White—1/3 yard (cut 2-1/2” strips x 4)

Border 2—Navy—1/4 yard (cut 1-1/2” strips x 4)

Border 3—Blue Swirls—7/8 yard (cut 4-1/2” strips x 6)

GO! Qube 6" Ziggy Zag Table Runner

Finished Size: 23" x 35"

Fabrics are from the Vineyard Collection and are provided by Island Batik



Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

- GO! Square-2" (1½" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-1½" Finished Square (Shape 5)







GO! Qube 6" Companion-Corners (55784)

- GO! Signature Block-3" Finished Square (Shape 10)

Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Dark Purple (A)	 10	Cut 2—4" x 22" strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 15—3" finished signature blocks.	Fat Quarter
Medium Purple (B)	 10	Cut 2—4" x 22" strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 15—3" finished signature blocks.	Fat Quarter
Almond (C)	 5	Cut 1—5¼" x 22" strip. Fanfold into 2¾" widths. Sub cut into 30—1½" finished half square triangles (HSTs).	Fat Quarter
Almond (D)	 1	Cut 6—4" x 22" strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 60—1½" finished squares.	Fat Quarter
Dark Green (E)	 1	Cut 3—4" x 22" strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 30—1½" finished squares.	Fat Quarter
Light Green (F)	 1	Cut 3—4" x 22" strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 30—1½" finished squares.	Fat Quarter

Additional Cutting Instructions:

- Light Purple (G)—¼ yard
 - Cut 2—1½" strips x 30½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024).
 - Cut 2—1½" strips x 20½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024).
- Dark Purple (H)—1 yard
 - Cut 2—2" x 32½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025).
 - Cut 2—2" x 23" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025).
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut binding.

Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Batting: 23" x 35"
- Backing: 1 yard

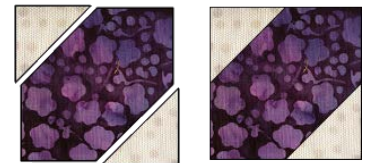
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

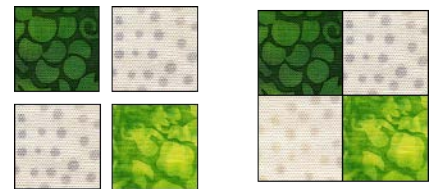
1. Pin and sew one cream (C) 1½" finished half square triangle (HST) on either side of a dark purple (A) 3" finished signature block as shown. Press seams toward the cream HSTs. Make 15 signature block units.



2. Pin and sew one cream (C) 1½" finished HST on either side of a medium purple (B) 3" finished signature block as shown. Press seams toward the cream HSTs. Make 15 signature block units.

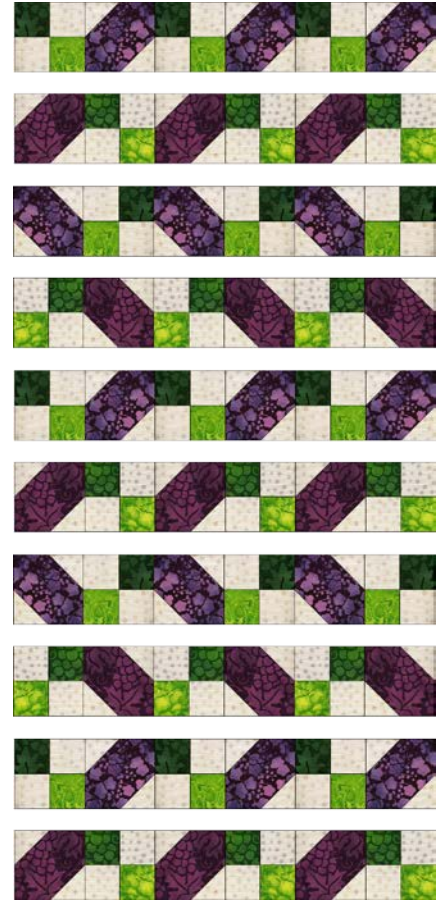


3. Pin and sew two cream (D), one dark green (E) and one medium green (F) 1½" finished squares together into a 4-patch as shown. Press seam open.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 10 rows of 6 blocks each as shown in the diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.



2. Sew 1—1½" x 30½" Fabric G strip to each side of the table runner. Sew 1—1½" x 20½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the table runner.



3. Sew 1—2" x 32½" Fabric H strip to each side of the table runner. Sew 1—2" x 23" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the table runner.



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
