Jelly Roll Rug Supply List

Jelly Roll Rug Pattern (included in class fee)

Jelly Roll (40-42 pieces) (You can also cut your own 2-1/2" strips.

Do this before arriving to class)

2-1/4" Batting on a Roll 50yd pkg (You can cut your own and piece together to make 50 yds. Do this before arriving to class)

Large spool of thread (approx. 1200 yds)

Stretch needle 90/14

4-5 bobbins

Sasher tool (optional but very helpful)

Wonder Clips if not using Sasher tool

Mary Ellen's Best Press

Quilting Gloves (optional)

Sewing Machine (must have zigzag capabilities)

Power cord

Foot Pedal

Extension table

Walking Foot

HOMEWORK:

Having the 2-1/2 fabric strips sewn together before class will make the construction of this rug go much quicker.

To do this, first choose how you'd like to arrange your strips. I generally like to have some darker strips on the outside edge and then I just use the strips as they come off the Jelly Roll for the rest of the rug. For the full rug, 3 strips should do that, but you can pick out 4 to be sure.

- 1) Starting with the OUTSIDE edge strips, sew all of the strips together using a diagonal seam. Same as you would to piece binding strips together. (If you do not know how to do this step, stop by and someone will show you.)
- 2) Once the strips are all sewn together, trim the diagonal seam to 1/4" and press seams open. Use Mary Ellen's Best Press on entire strip as you press.
- 3) Fan-fold the long strip into 12"-16" increments.
- 4) Prewind your bobbins.
