Vinyl[*] (label) SUP151	Not used	3½" x 5½"	4½" x 6½"
Thread to match fabrics	SoFine #50 polyester thread		

§TIP: One yard of main and one yard of lining fabric will make all three bins plus one more small bin. Additional lining fabric will be required if using directional fabric.
