## Quilt Yardages:

Fabric A: RA10 762 W ..... $7 / 8$ yard
Fabric B: BSAN 4840 PA ..... one panel
Fabric C: BSAN 4842 MU ..... $17 / 8$ yards
Fabric D: BSAN 4844 S ..... 7/8 yard
Fabric E: BSAN 4845 MU ..... $1 / 4$ yard
Fabric F: BSAN 4846 G ..... 3/8 yard
Backing: BSAN 4843 G suggested ..... $31 / 2$ yards
Batting ..... $61 " x 67$

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces. LOF = length of fabric.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut six $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut twelve $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2" and twelve $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. (Pieced blocks and cornerstones)
2. Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Inner Border \#2)
3. Cut five 2" strips. Subcut two 2" x 41 1/2" from two strips. Piece remaining strips and subcut two 2" x 44 1/2" strips. (Inner Border \#4)

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut six $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ 1/2" panel rectangles, centering designs. (Quilt Center Panel Blocks)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut four $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips centering design within each strip. Cut two strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59$ "and two strips 6 1/2" x 65". (Outer Border)


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## From Fabric D:

1. Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut six $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and six $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. (Sashing rectangles)
2. Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips. (Inner Border \#1)
3. Cut seven 2 1/4" strips. (Binding)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut one $61 / \mathbf{2 " ~}^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut three $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Subcut twelve $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Blocks)
2. Cut four $11 / 2$ " strips. Subcut two $11 / 2$ " $\times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from two strips. Use leftover fabric and piece with remaining two strips. Subcut two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips.
(Inner Border \#3)

## Piecing Instructions:

## Pieced Blocks

1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A rectangles to the opposite long sides of one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ E rectangle. Sew two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"A rectangles to the top and bottom of the same E rectangle. (Figure 1)
2. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ rectangles to the opposite long sides of Step 1 unit. Sew two


Figure 1 Make 3. $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{F}$ rectangles to the remaining short sides of the same unit.
3. Sew two 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" A rectangles to the opposite long sides of Step 2 unit. Sew two 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" A rectangles to the remaining opposite short sides of the same unit to complete one pieced block. Block measures 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
Make a total of three pieced blocks. (Figure 2)

## Quilt Assembly:

Refer to Quilt Diagram.

1. Refer to quilt diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew together two $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ B blocks, one pieced block and two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of three pieced rows.
2. Sew three $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ 1/2" D rectangles and two 1 1/2" A squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of two sashing rows.
3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.
4. Inner border \#1. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
5. Inner border \#2. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
6. Inner border \#3. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ F strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Inner border \#4. Sew two 2" x 44 1/2" A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two 2" x 41 1/2" A strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
8. Outer Border. Sew two $61 / 2 " \times 65$ " C strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, matching the strip center to quilt center. Begin and end seams $1 / 4 "$ from each end. Repeat with two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59$ " C strips to the top and bottom of quilt center. Close corners with mitered corners. Trim seams to $1 / 2$ " and press open. Quilt top should measure 53 1/2" x 59 1/2" unfinished.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing with one vertical seam to measure 61" x 67" Press seam open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join nine $21 / 4$ " D binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
